
Walt,

Here is the information you requested. I recently changed insurance companies, and did not know I had to have financial responsibility on my license. I was sent a letter from the Registry notifying me I needed it by 11/14/16 so I proceeded to get it in place. I had it in place on 11/11/16. The insurance company told me that they would inform the Registry so at that time I thought I was okay until a friend of mine told me he had a similar problem and his license was suspended so I took it upon myself to go to North Providence Police and check my license. They told me my license was suspended due to lack of financial responsibility. I knew I had it in place so I immediately went to the Registry and checked with them.

When I sat with the woman at the Registry she told me they had all the paperwork they needed but it was not received until 11/18/16 because the Registry is not electronically connected to the insurance company and they only use hard copies. If I knew that I would have hand delivered the insurance form because mail takes longer than usual because the whole complex in Cranston uses one mail room for Registry, Courts, Prison, etc.

They documented in my file that I had insurance in place on 11/11/16 and I was in compliance. It was a paper mistake. Enclosed are the insurance form and reinstatement letter. Once again if I knew there was a problem I would have addressed it right away.
